The Special Meeting of the Board of Education of Canton Union School District #66 was held Wednesday, March 18, 2020, beginning at 6:45 PM in the Boardroom Administration Building, 20 West Walnut Street Canton, Illinois.

1. CALL TO ORDER

Board President Leonard Barnard called the regular meeting to order at 6:45 PM in the Boardroom at the Administration Building.

2. ROLL CALL
