The second week of February has seen a dramatic drop in the number of quarantined and positive staff. For example, the number of quarantined and COVID positive staff members have dropped 50% in one week. In two weeks the positivity rate has dropped 83% and the quarantine rate has dropped 88%. We attribute this to masks and social distancing. Similarly, the student positivity rate has dropped 50% and

the quarantine rate has dropped nearly 70% in one week. Again, we attribute this to the lowering of staff quarantine and positivity rate to the use of PPE and social distancing.

Another important factor is the inoculation of our staff members. Over the past two weekends over 300 Canton SCUD #66 staff members have been inoculated to prevent the spread of the COVID virus. The program was administered by the health department and extremely successful. To date, Fulton County is one of the top 5 counties within the state for inoculation rates. This is great news that will put us on the road to normalcy. Most importantly it allows us to keep the schools open.

Another important statistic for our school district is our inventory of PPE. Currently district-wide we have the following PPE items. Currently, there is no shortage of PPE throughout the country. Nonetheless, it is important for us to keep an accurate inventory so we don't run out.
