From a COVID perspective last week was a rough week for Canton Schools. For example, after finishing the week of 4/19 with very low COVID numbers the virus has come back with a roar. Again, the increased positivity rate is a good example of how the virus can be aggressive and come back. Interestingly enough, none of the positive cases were infected at school. This is good news since this indicates that the school setting is still a safe place to be for staff and students. This has been a consistent trend throughout the pandemic.

This Thursday the Fulton County Health Department will be conducting a Pfizer and Johnson & Johnson vaccination clinic. There are many advantages to those that choose to be vaccinated. For example,

according to the CDC, vaccinated people who are exposed to someone with a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case do not need to quarantine if they meet the following criteria:

- Are fully vaccinated (i.e., ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series, or ≥ 2 weeks following receipt of one dose of a single-dose vaccine)
- Are within 3 months following receipt of the last dose in the series
- Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure

The clinic will be administering the Johnson & Johnson vaccine for those people 18 years of age and older from 9 to 3:30. From 4 to 6 the Pfizer vaccine will be administered for 16 & 17 year olds. You can learn more about the vaccination clinic on the Canton Facebook Page.
